

KB-Protect Wordpress Dashboard (Admin Console) With MFA Using DUO

- Go to <https://duo.com>
- Log in with your administrative credentials or create an account (free up to 5 users).
- Create a "user" with the username that you use to authenticate to the Wordpress dashboard. Hint: if you already have a user created you can add an alias to the existing user.
- Add a phone associated with the user in the lower section of the add menu so the user will be able to interact with the DUO app and receive a DUO Push.

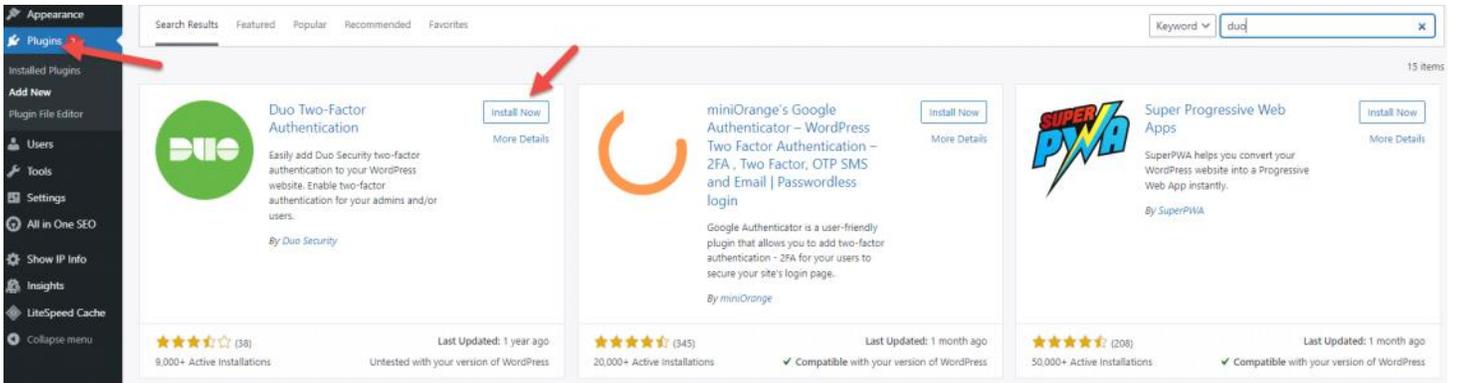

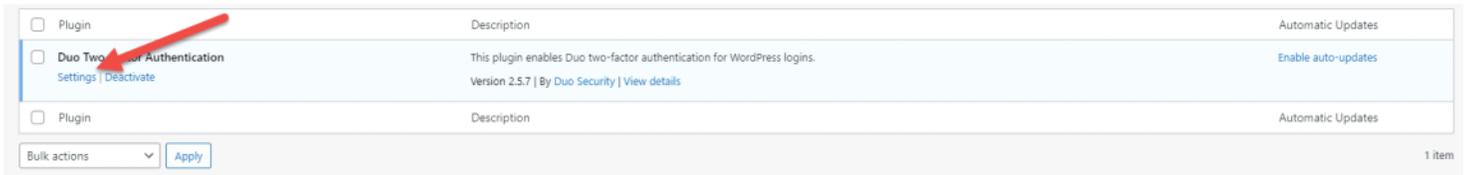
Activate Windows

- Now go to your Wordpress Dashboard (admin control panel), hover over plugins and select to add new.

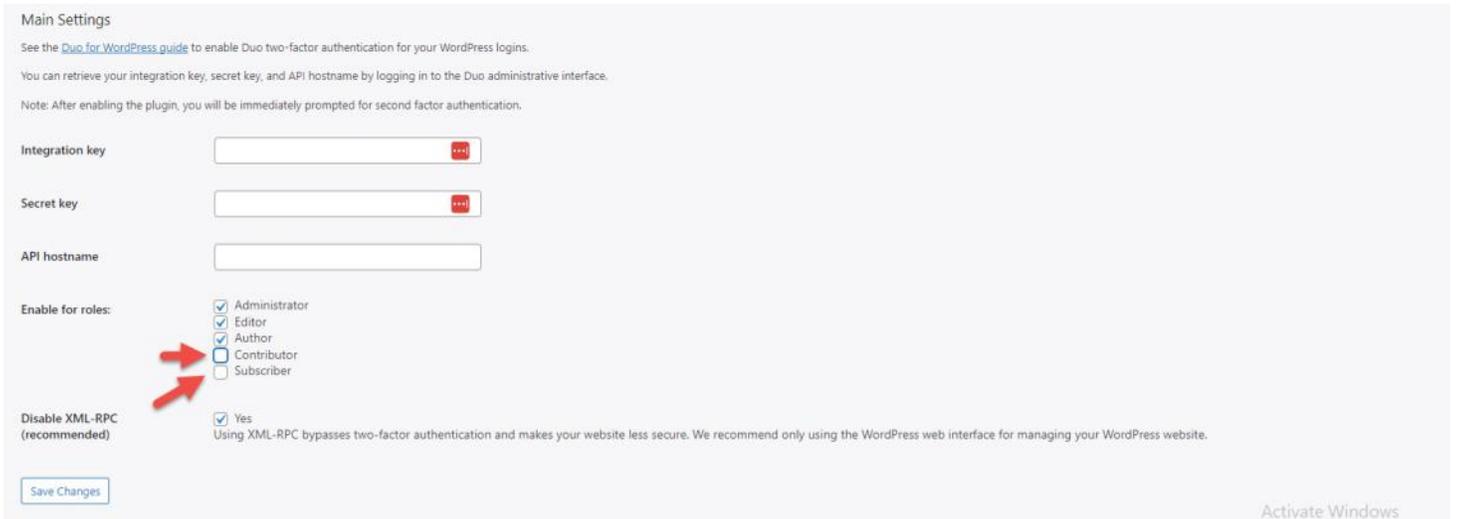
- Next search for DUO and choose install on the DUO Two Factor Authentication plugin. Then click activate.



- Go to your "Installed Plugins" and select settings.



- Now, copy in your IKEY, Secret Key, and API Hostname and untick contributor and subscriber then click save changes.



- After clicking save changes, the DUO prompt will walk you through verifying your phone number and you can authenticate with a test DUO Push.
